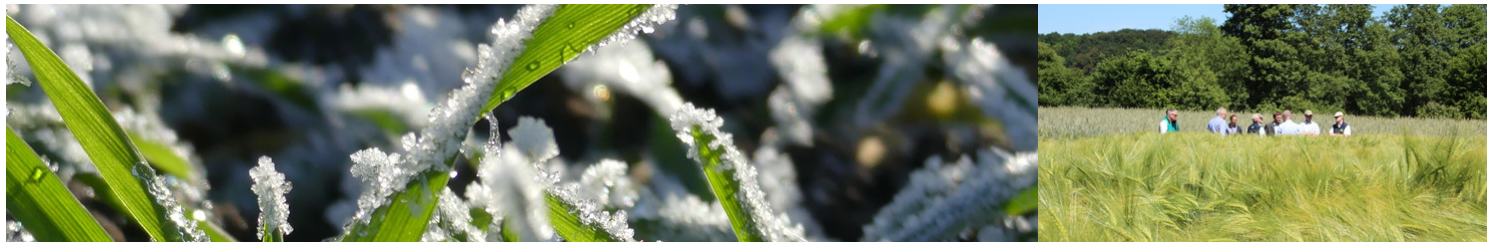


# MIRABELLE 6-row

The feed talent with allround suitability



## Advantages:

- Midlate, robust longer single-ear type with good straw stability and average health profile
- High winter hardness, listed and tested in Poland
- Good tillering after winter
- Best lodging tolerance

## Cultivation:

Suitable for all growing areas, especially medium and better soils  
 Soils with high N-supply, due to good straw stability  
 Early sowing possible

## Short profile:

---- = very low resistance/early/short,

++++ = very high resistance/late/long
