Accepted in Europe and South America by major maltsters and brewers

Advantages:

- SHAKIRA has good malting quality with high diastatic power
- Listed on Heineken "List of preferred varieties" (=Green List)
- Resistance against mildew and rhynchosporium

Cultivation:

SHAKIRA fits well under hot and dry climates. Low treatment due to its high disease resistance.
